"Confidence, conversation/social skills, respect and school work I have viewed/listened to from my child'

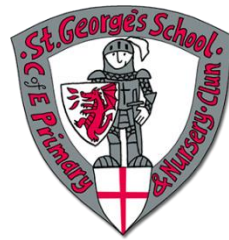
'Treating everyone with respect. Being kind to each other. It's a caring community.'
