Expressive Arts and Design:

- Share their creations, explaining the process they have used.

End of KS1

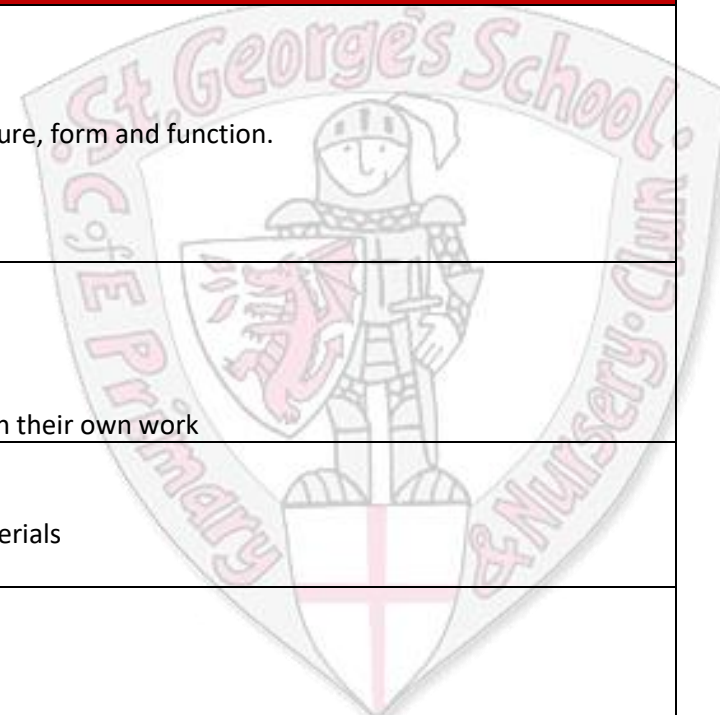
- Use materials creatively to design and make products
- Use drawing painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experience and imagination
- Develop art techniques e.g. colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form, space
- Know about the work of artists, craft makers, designers their differences and similarities and making links in their own work

End of KS2

- Children create sketchbooks to record observations, to review and revisit ideas
- Know how to improve mastery of art techniques including drawing, painting, sculpture with a range of materials
- Know about great artists, architects and designers in history

Children will leave St George's as artists who:

- Are confident and comfortable with their creativity in whatever form it takes
- Have confidence to express themselves creatively
- Demonstrate dexterity, coordination, improved fine motor skills
- Make connections to their inner self, others and the wider world
- Appreciate, discuss and evaluate art
